ORDINANCE NO. 2016-O-01**

**ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 139.09 TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
ESTABLISHING TIME PERIODS FOR THE PLACEMENT OF GARBAGE OR TRASH  
OUT FOR COLLECTION AND REMOVAL THEREOF**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio that:

**SECTION I**           The following provision shall be added to the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Lincoln Heights and codified in Title XIII, Chapter 139 as Section 139.09.

*(A) No person shall place refuse, trash or garbage at the curb or curb line before 5:00 p.m. on the day before the scheduled pick up day. If the scheduled pick up day is a holiday, the refuse pick up is the following work day.*

*(B) Any receptacle used to place such refuse, trash or garbage at the curb or curb line shall be removed before 9:00 a.m. on the day after the scheduled pick up day. As used herein, "removed" means that said receptacle shall not be visible from the front of any dwelling.*

*(C) Whoever violates or fails to comply with this Section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$100 for each offense. A separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during or on which a violation or noncompliance occurs or continues.*

**SECTION II**           Upon passage, the italicized language contained in Section I shall be codified in Title XIII, Chapter 139, Section 139.09, of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Lincoln Heights and titled **SET OUT OF GARBAGE OR TRASH**. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward this Ordinance upon passage to the codification service provider for the Village and to instruct said provider to codify this Ordinance in accordance with this Section II.
