**ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 110, SECTION 110.23 OF THE
CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING ISSUANCE OF A BUSINESS LICENSE.**

WHEREAS, Title 11, Chapter 110, Section 110.23 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio provides for a graduated increase in the business license fee and the publication of a schedule therefore; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights deems that it would be in the best interest of the Village to repeal said provision and provide a single business license fee; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED By the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio:


SECTION I A copy of Title 11, Chapter 110, Section 110.23 is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. It is hereby repealed in its entirety and in its place shall read as follow:

The license fee shall be \$100.00.

SECTION II Upon passage, the language contained in Section I shall be codified in Title XI, Chapter 110, Section 110.23 of the Code of Ordinances for the Village of Lincoln Heights. The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward this Ordinance upon passage to the codification service provider for the Village and to instruct said provider to codify this Ordinance in accordance with this Section II.

SECTION III This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety and welfare. The reason for said emergency is the need to update and stabilize the license fee for individuals or companies engaging in business within the Village of Lincoln Heights.

EXHIBIT A

§ 110.22 ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

On receipt of such application for a license, accompanied by the proper fee, the Village Manager, shall forthwith deposit the fee in the treasury and issue to the applicant a proper license certificate. If for any reason the license is not issued, the aforesaid deposit shall be returned to the applicant.

§ 110.23 DATE AND DURATION OF LICENSE; FEE.

(A) The Current License Fee shall increase 5% effective January 1, 2009 resulting in a License Fee of \$52.50 for 2009. Thereafter, the License Fee shall increase 5% for each successive calendar year ("Annual Increase") until such time that the License Fee is \$100.00 whereupon the Annual Increase shall cease and the License Fee shall be and remain at \$100.00.

(B) The Village Manager, or his or her appointed designee, shall immediately create a License Fee schedule itemizing the Annual Increase for 2009 and each successive calendar year through the calendar year when the License Fee reaches \$100.00. Said schedule shall immediately be forwarded to all businesses known to be operating within the Village.
