**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO SELL PERSONAL PROPERTY  
NOT NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS,** The Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, owns a 1991 Sutphin Pumper Engine Fire Truck bearing VIN #159A1BFDXM1003874 and related equipment ("Vehicle"), which the Fire Department no longer needs;

**WHEREAS,** Fire Chief Maurice Byrd has approved the sale of the Vehicle; and

**WHEREAS,** The Vehicle is no longer needed for a municipal purpose.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to sell the Vehicle in accordance with the provisions of O.R.C. §721.15(B).

**SECTION II** This Resolution is hereby determined to be an emergency measure, necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The reason for said emergency is the need to dispose of personal property which the Village owns but no longer needs for municipal purposes.
