RESOLUTION NO. 2017-R-20**

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION IN THE VILLAGE OF LINCOLN HEIGHTS, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO FOR THE PURPOSE OF GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING, AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS, AND BRIDGES

WHEREAS, The Village of Lincoln Heights has determined it necessary to place a question on the November 2017 ballot to levy a tax pursuant to Section 5705.19(G), for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads and bridges; and

WHEREAS, The Village has determined that seven (7) mills in excess of the ten-mill limitation for each one dollar of valuation would be an appropriate levy for the previously stated purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I It is hereby declared that the amount of taxes which may be raised in the Village of Lincoln Heights within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the Village.

SECTION II Pursuant to the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, it is necessary to levy a tax, which is in excess of the ten (10) mill limitation for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads and bridges, at a rate not to exceed seven (7) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation for a continuing period of time beginning January 1, 2018.

SECTION III The question of the adoption of said tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Lincoln Heights at the election to be held on November 7, 2017.

SECTION IV Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 5705.25, the form of the ballot to be used at the election shall be as follows:

A majority affirmative vote is
necessary for passage

An additional tax for the benefit of the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads and bridges at a rate not to exceed seven (7) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to seventy cents (\$.70) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuous period of time commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018.



SECTION V The Clerk is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, not later than four o'clock (4:00) p.m. on the ninetieth (90th) day before the date of said election and to notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of the election on the question of levying the tax to be given as required by law.

SECTION VI It is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to the passage of the Resolution were done in an open meeting of Council, and all deliberations of Council and of any of its committees that resulted in the formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22.


SECTION VII Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 5705.19, this Resolution goes into effect immediately upon passage and no publication is necessary other than provided for in the notice of election.
