RESOLUTION NO. 2017-R-3**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO APPLY  
FOR A SAFE ROUTE TO SCHOOL GRANT**

**WHEREAS,** The Safe Routes To School ("SRTS") program provides funds for safety projects that encourage or enable children in grades K-8, including those with disabilities, to walk or ride their bikes to school;

**WHEREAS,** Monies for SRTS projects are available through the state of Ohio, Department of Transportation ("ODOT");

**WHEREAS,** ODOT's SRTS funds can be used for two types of projects in five categories, to-wit: engineering, education, encouragement, enforcement, and evaluation; and,

**WHEREAS,** Local Public Agencies ("LPA") can apply for these monies and be selected for funding by ODOT.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I** The Village of Lincoln Heights shall be the LPA for purposes of the SRTS program.

**SECTION II** The Village Manager is hereby empowered on behalf of the LPA to prepare and execute an application for SRTS funds for the stated project and to submit the same to ODOT.

**SECTION III** If awarded SRTS funds ("Funds"), the LPA agrees to pay 100% of the Funds toward the cost of the project.

**SECTION IV** Upon completion of the SRTS project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall:

1. Provide adequate maintenance for the SRTS project in accordance with all applicable state and federal laws, including, but not limited to, 23 U.S.C. § 116;

2. Provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described project;

3. If necessary, maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstruction; and

4. If necessary, hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

**SECTION V**

If the application is approved for the funding, the Village Manager is hereby empowered on behalf of the LPA to enter into a contract with the director of ODOT necessary to complete the SRTS project.

**SECTION VI**

This Resolution is hereby determined an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. Specifically, the reason for said emergency is the need to pass this Resolution and have it take effect in time to meet the Safe Route to School application deadline of March 3, 2017.
