RESOLUTION NO. 2018-R-11**

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL FUND FOR PROCEEDS DERIVED FROM THE
INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY**

WHEREAS, Council passed Resolution No. 2017-R-20 declaring the necessity to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation in the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges;

WHEREAS, The residents of the Village of Lincoln Heights voted on the Levy ("Levy") at the November 2017 general election and as a result of such vote, the Levy was passed;

WHEREAS, O.R.C. § 5705.09(D) requires the Village to establish a special fund for each Special Levy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I There is hereby created "The Infrastructure Fund", to be established by the Finance Department and administered by the Finance Director for the receipt of monies from the Levy.

SECTION II The Finance Director shall record the appropriations in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Levy.

SECTION III This ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The reason for said emergency is the need to create a fund for the deposit of monies received from the Levy.
