**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO DISCARD OR SALVAGE
PERSONAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE VILLAGE**

WHEREAS, One of the many issues facing Lincoln Heights in continuing with its own Fire Department was the aging fire vehicles used to provide fire protection services to the residents of Lincoln Heights;

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights previously passed Resolution No. 2017-R-35 authorizing the Village Manager to execute an agreement with the Village of Woodlawn, Hamilton County, Ohio to provide fire and emergency medical services for Lincoln Heights ("Agreement");

WHEREAS, That Agreement was signed earlier this year, and the Village of Woodlawn has provided Lincoln Heights with fire and emergency medical services since February 1, 2018; and,

WHEREAS, Part of the consideration for the Agreement was the transfer to Woodlawn of Lincoln Heights' aging fire vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I Pursuant to O.R.C. §721.15(C), the Village Manager is hereby authorized to discard personal property owned by Lincoln Heights and more particularly described on **Exhibit A** attached hereto and made a part hereof ("Property") and transfer the same to Woodlawn. The Property is obsolete and unfit for the use for which it was acquired; therefore, it has no value.

SECTION II This Resolution is hereby determined to be an emergency matter necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The reason for said emergency is the need to discard the Property owned by Lincoln Heights which is obsolete and unfit for the use for which it was acquired, and which therefore has no value.
