**RESOLUTION APPOINTING ALICIA GILBERT TO THE TAX BOARD OF REVIEW**

**WHEREAS,** A vacancy exists on the Board which needs to be filled.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I** Alicia Gilbert is hereby appointed to the Board.

**SECTION II** Her appointment is retroactive to January 1, 2018 and is for a four-year term terminating on December 31, 2021.

**SECTION III** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The reason for said emergency is the need to fill a vacancy on the Tax Board of Review so that it can perform the functions entrusted to it by the Village Charter.
