**RESOLUTION APPOINTING GARY BROWN TO THE EDUCATION COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS,** Section 11.08 of the Village Charter establishes an Education Commission ("Commission") consisting of five members who serve four year staggered terms;

**WHEREAS,** A vacancy exists on the Commission which needs to be filled.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I** Gary Brown is hereby appointed to the Education Commission

**SECTION II** His appointment is retroactive to January 1, 2018 and is for a four-year term terminating on December 31, 2021.

**SECTION III** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The reason for said emergency is the need to fill a vacancy on the Education Commission so that it can perform the functions entrusted to it by the Village Charter.
