**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DONNA POPE AS A SIGNER ON
THE U.S. BANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION ACCOUNT CONNECTED
WITH THE GENERAL FUND ACCOUNT FOR THE VILLAGE**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I Pursuant to 2005-R-19, Donna Pope is hereby designated as an Authorized Signer of checks, drafts or other orders for the payment, transfer or withdrawal of any of the funds or other property of the Village of Lincoln Heights on deposit with U.S. Bank National Association in its general fund account.

SECTION II Pursuant to Resolution 2005-R-21, the Clerk shall immediately certify to U.S. Bank the name and signature of Donna Pope.

SECTION III As an Authorized Signer, Donna Pope shall be subject to the rules of U.S. Bank National Association and legislation defining the rights and restrictions of Authorized Signers, including 2005-R-19.

SECTION IV This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The reason for said emergency is the need to provide Donna Pope immediate access to the Village's general fund account in case it is necessary to handle the financial affairs of the Village.
