RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO REMOVE THE VILLAGE MANAGER FROM OFFICE

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Lincoln Heights has determined it to be in the best interest of the residents of the Village of Lincoln Heights to remove Rebecca A. Hopkins as Village Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. Council intends to remove Rebecca A. Hopkins as the Village Manager pursuant to Section 3.05 of the Village Charter for misuse of the Village credit card.


SECTION II. The Village Manager is hereby suspended from duty without pay for a period of 30 days effective June 26, 2018.

SECTION III. Council hereby appoints Donna Pope to be the acting Village Manager until Rebecca A. Hopkins is restored to duty as Manager or until Council shall appoint a person to the position of Manager as provided for under the Charter.
