**WHEREAS,** Rebecca A. Hopkins was suspended without pay for thirty (30) days, effective June 26, 2018, pursuant to Resolution No. 2018-R-34


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I.** US Bank National Association is hereby instructed to remove Rebecca A. Hopkins as an authorized signer from all accounts for the Village effective immediately, including without limitation the general fund account.

**SECTION II.** Upon passage, the Finance Director shall immediately notify US Bank that Rebecca A. Hopkins is no longer an authorized signer on any accounts for the Village.

**SECTION III.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The reason for said emergency is the need to ensure the Village financial affairs are properly cared for.


