WHEREAS, A vacancy exists on the Planning Commission; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I Council, pursuant to Section 11.02 of the Lincoln Heights Charter, hereby approves the appointment of Morris Hodge to the Planning Commission for a four (4) year term commencing as of January 1, 2018 and expiring on December 31, 2021.

SECTION II This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. Specifically, the reason for said emergency is the immediate need to fill a vacancy on the Planning Commission.


