**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SALARY FOR DONNA POPE WHILE SERVING AS INTERIM
VILLAGE MANAGER IN FISCAL YEAR 2019**

WHEREAS, The Village Manager, Rebecca A. Hopkins, was removed from office pursuant to Resolution No. 2018-R-40;

WHEREAS, Donna Pope was appointed interim Village Manager pursuant to Resolution No. 2018-R-34 and said appointment is continuing until such time as Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights appoints a person to the position of Manager; and

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 2.05(1) of the Charter requires Council to establish the Manager's salary through legislation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I That Donna Pope shall be paid, effective January 1, 2019, the gross amount of \$1,410.23, bi-weekly, for fiscal year 2019 while she serves as Interim Village Manager for the Village of Lincoln Heights ("**Pay Increase**").

SECTION II This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety and welfare. The reason for such emergency is the need to properly compensate Donna Pope while she serves as Interim Village Manager and to provide legislative authority for the Pay Increase.
