
**RESOLUTION APPOINTING ROBERT T. BUTLER AS ASSISTANT LAW DIRECTOR
TO PROSECUTE PROTEST FILED WITH BOARD OF ELECTIONS**

- WHEREAS,** The Law Director for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Deepak K. Desai, filed a protest on behalf of the Village regarding the qualifications of certain individuals to run for the office of Council Member; and
- WHEREAS,** The Board of Elections scheduled a hearing on the protest for September 10, 2019 at 8:30 A.M.; and
- WHEREAS,** Deepak K. Desai has a previously scheduled hearing before Judge Jody Luebbers on September 10, 2019 at 9:00 A.M.; and
- WHEREAS,** The attorneys of Donnellon, Donnellon & Miller, LPA, where Deepak K. Desai works, represent several municipalities; and
- WHEREAS,** Robert T. Butler is one of those attorneys; and
- WHEREAS,** Robert T. Butler is available for the hearing scheduled before the Board of Elections; and
- WHEREAS,** The Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights believes it would be in the best interest of the Village to have Robert T. Butler represent the Village regarding the protest filed before the Board of Elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

- SECTION I.** Robert T. Butler is hereby appointed Assistant Law Director for the Village of Lincoln Heights for the purpose of prosecuting the protest filed on behalf of the Village regarding the qualifications of certain individuals to run for the office of Council Member and filed with the Board of Elections.
- SECTION II.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The reason for said emergency is the need to officially appoint Robert T. Butler as Assistant Law Director to prosecute the protest on behalf of the Village before the Board of Elections.
