RESOLUTION NO. 2019-R-15**

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY MATTERS IN CONNECTION  
WITH THE RENEWAL OF THE GENERAL OPERATING LEVY FOR 2020**

**WHEREAS,** The Village of Lincoln Heights has determined it necessary to place a question on the November 2019 ballot for the purpose of renewing the sixteen-mill operating levy passed in 2015 ("Existing Levy"); and

**WHEREAS,** The Village has determined that renewal of the Existing Levy would be appropriate for the general operation of the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I** It is hereby declared that the amount of taxes which may be raised in the Village of Lincoln Heights within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the current expenses of the Village.

**SECTION II** Pursuant to the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code § 5705.19 , it is necessary to renew the Existing Levy which is in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of providing necessary funds for current expenses of the Village, at the rate not to exceed sixteen (16) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation for a five year period of time beginning January 1, 2021, which is a renewal of the Existing Levy in the amount of 16 mills.

**SECTION III** The question of the adoption of said tax levy renewal shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Lincoln Heights at the election to be held on November 5, 2019. If approved by a majority of the electors voting at such election, the tax levy renewal shall first be placed upon the 2020 tax list and duplicate for first collection in the calendar year 2021.

**SECTION IV** The Clerk is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Auditor at the earliest possible time so that the County Auditor may certify such matters in accordance with Ohio Revised Code § 5705.03 to be able to consider, pass and file a Resolution of Tax Levy for consideration at the November 5, 2019 general election.

**SECTION V** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The

reason for said emergency is the necessity to meet deadlines in order for the levy to be on the November 2019 ballot.
